



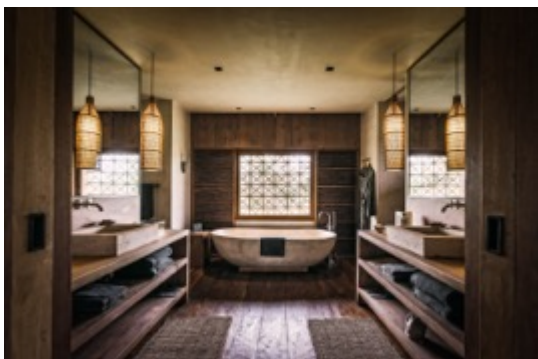
## Phum Baitang

### A green paradise in the heart of Cambodia

A short 20-minute drive from the Angkor temple, in the flourishing region of Siem Reap can be found a 'green village' that is as discrete as it is captivating. #### *An exceptional resort*

Lying amongst tranquil rice fields worked by buffalos, on eight hectares of land and surrounded by a luxuriant natural environment, this village was built in 2015, comprising 45 villas to make a novel village of truly Cambodian style. The traditional architecture is an unexpected cocktail of rustic materials and amazingly natural sophistication.



This majestic resort can host up to 90 guests. Twenty individual villas of 130 m<sup>2</sup>, each with a garden and private swimming pool, and 25 other villas of 80m<sup>2</sup> with a large terrace, make up this architecturally authentic village. Each villa has a bathroom and separate WC, a dressing room, and enjoys the latest technological innovations while scrupulously respecting the natural uniqueness of the site. At Phum Baitang, beauty and discretion make for a perfect math. It is no mistake,

therefore, that one of the most well-known American accesses has decided to make the village her base for months at a time to peacefully revitalise herself.

### *A unique experience*

The unique, signature hospitality of Zannier Hotels that is dedicated to offering ultimate comfort to its guests can be seen at all times and in every detail of this place. At Phum Baitang, there is no lack of activities for the entire family, ranging from a joint cooking lesson to an afternoon spent exploring the Cambodian culture and rice-growing, or a walk with water buffaloes through the rice paddies .....these are just some of the activities that are offered to guests wishing to enrich their experience and learn more about local culture.



In the surrounding area, Angkor is one of the obvious archaeological must-dos to undertake, or one can choose to explore the rivers or visit the fishing villages to enjoy another type of exhilarating but soothing experience.

For the more active guests, there is an 18-hole golf course at Angkor, designed by the famous Nick Faldo. Finally, there is the Tonle Sap lake, the largest expanse of fresh water in south-east Asia, offering an incredible diving experience in pure limpid water.

These wonderful excursions having whet the appetite, Phum Baitang becomes a site of gastronomic excellence with its two restaurants. Hang Bay offers fusion cuisine of local dishes, local sea-food delights and fresh steaks, all to be enjoyed while watching the glorious sunset.
