THE PALETTE

Linen upholstery, dark green walls and antique furniture complement 1898 The Post's late 19th century architecture. 1898 The Post is a hotel located in the Belgian city of Ghent. Facing the Graslei Canal, it's close to many of the city's main attractions. The hotel sits within the walls of the city's historic post office building. Designed by architect Louis Cloquet in collaboration with Stephane Mortier for the 1913 World exhibition, the building is eclectic in style, with predominantly neo-Gothic and neo-Renaissance influences, echoing the beautiful façade of the Gildehuis der Vrije Schippers along the Graslei Canal.
