

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



5. Pablo y Walter, Boutinot, Mendoza

14.1%, Malbec, Sustainable

Produced from 25 year old vines in the Agrelo district of Mendoza, close to Walter's bodega in the rain shadow of the Cordon del Plata. This creation results in a medium-bodied wine, richly bloody, vibrant, and velvety.

AUSTRALIA

6. Gentle Folks, Adelaide

12,8%, Shiraz, Biodynamic

With a background in phycology (the study of seaweed and algae), both Gareth and Rainbo developed a keen interest in wine and applied their knowledge of microbiology to quickly became influential figures in the Adelaide Hills wine scene, with an emphasis on minimal intervention and regional expression. Medium to full body. Juicy plum, blackcurrant. Tannic.

7. The Last Stand, Boutinot, Victoria

14%, Shiraz, Malbec, Vegan

Outstandingly good value Aussie super fruity shiraz from the cool-climate Victoria region. Full body. Medium intensity.

CHILE

8. El Viejo del Valle, Boutinot, Valle Central 13.5%, Pinot Noir, **Vegan** 1.300

Deliciously long, bright, textural Pinot from cold, stony vineyards deep in the Central Valley's old glacial riverbeds. Summer fruits of red currant, raspberry and wild strawberries on the nose follow through to a juicy palate. A touch of oak adds spice complexity. Medium body. Smooth & dry.

9. Escudo Rojo Riserva, Baron P. Rothschild Escudo, Casablanca Valley 14%, Cabernet Franc, Sauvignon, Carmenere 1.800

Escudo Rojo emerged from the intersection of cross-generational expertise, and pioneering exploration, blending the historical craftsmanship of Baron de Philippe de Rothschild with Chile's finest terroirs. This results in a full-bodied wine, a Bordeaux blend characterized by moderate tannins and acidity.

FRANCE

10. Les Charmantes, Saint Nicolas de Bourqueil, Loire Valley

12,5%, Cabernet Franc, Organic

From selected vineyards and wine-makers located in Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil Estates bottled. Typical and intense rustic Cabernet smell followed by roundness in mouth. Medium body.

11. Domaine Tollot Beaut, Burgundy

13%, Pinot Noir, Organic

Domaine Tollot-Beaut was one of the first domaine to bottle its own wines back in 1921. This is a super little wine that will give immense pleasure. Light to medium body. Elegant and fresh. Soft tannins and a relatively low acidity.

12. Sol Béni, Philippe Troussier, Saint Émilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux

14%, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Biodynamic

Winenery owned by Philippe Troussier, current manager of the Vietnam national football team. Full body. Tannic, dry and round.



17. Le Pur Fruit du Causse, Château Combel La Serre, South West, Cahors

1.700 12.5%, Malbec, **Organic**

A harmonious fusion of appellations from Bordeaux, presenting a full-bodied profile. Its texture is both fleshy and rounded, with a delightful burst of fruity notes that elevate the tasting experience

14. Les Raisins De La Colère, Invidia Vin de France, Bordeaux

14%, Merlot, Natural

This cuvée came straight from the mind of Jean-Pierre Derouet, the owner, a true free-thinker who cares more about the quality and soul of his wines than about respecting the codes of Bordeaux. This cuvée coming from Château Aurore is a sulfur-free wine, with no intrant to allow a fully expression of the fruit. Fun full body.

15. Le Cancre, Château Haut Meyreau, Vin de France, Bordeaux 14%, Merlot,

Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Organic

This cuvée is an ode to Invindia wine owners and a schoolboy who left school at a very young age. It is with his free-thinking spirit that he gave these vineyards this desire to do things their own way, to free themselves from the codes and dogmas of Bordeaux viticulture. With a full body and pronounced tannins, it embodies a straightforward yet pleasurable wine experience.

16. Château Durfort-Vivens, Margaux, Grand Cru Classé, Bordeaux

13%, Cab. Sauvignon, Merlot, Biodynamic

Revealing a deep, glossy cuttlefish ink color, the wine captivates with its intense notes and a profound bouquet. A remarkable balance unfolds on the palate, blending sweetness, freshness, and undeniable power. Originating from a fantastic year, this vintage exemplifies greatness, boasting a full-bodied magnificence that characterizes the finest Margaux expressions.

Julien and Sophie cultivate a 22-hectare farm situated on the lofty terrains of La Causse, a term hailing from the ancient Occitan language, evoking the region's limestone plateau. Their exclusive focus on the Malbec grape variety, coupled with a deliberate avoidance of oak influence, characterizes their distinctive winemaking approach. Embracing certified organic practices since 2013, they embody a philosophy dedicated to crafting wines meant for pure enjoyment — referred to as "vins de soif" with a genuine "joie de vivre". Particularly refreshing when served slightly chilled during the warmer summer months, the result is nothing short of radically brilliant. Medium to full body.

18. Equinoxe, Maxime Graillot, Crozes-Hermitage, Northern Rhône Valley

13.5%, Syrah, Biodynamic

2.900

Maxime Graillot ferments and ages his wines in concrete and large wooden vats to let the minerality and earthy qualities shine through. He is famous for producing fruit-forward red wines made from the Syrah grape; wines that boast a harmonious blend of flavoursaccentuated by velvety, supple tannins that contribute to their overall accessibility. Full body. Medium acidity. Chalky tannins.

19. Les Albizzias, Domaine Saint Etienne, Côtes du Rhône, Southern Rhône 14%, Grenache,

Syrah, Mourvedre, Carignan, **Biodynamic**



23. Clin d'oeil. Mas Lau. Cévènes

The Œillade is a cousin of the cinsault, vinified by Laurent Bagnol. It is a grape variety that will seduce you with its exotic aromas. Medium body. Bright. Rustic and wild wine, full of

ITALY

24. Fiulot, Prunotto, Barbera d'Asti, Piemonte 1.600 13.5%. Barbera

"Fiulot" in Piemonte's local dialect means "young man". This Barbera is delicate and easy to drink, a youthful expression of its fruit and aromas. Medium body, vinous, fruity and pleasant.

25. Barolo, Prunotto, Barbera d'Asti, Piemonte 5.500 14%. Nebbiolo

A traditional Barolo, one of Prunotto's historic labels, whose first vintage was produced in 1905 from the best grapes of the vineyards in the heart of the Barolo appellation. Aging takes place in large oak barrels of various sizes, further enhancing the extraordinary typicity of Nebbiolo in this region.Medium + body, full palate, well-balanced, silky tannins & persistent, rich finish.

26. Casanova di Neri. Brunello Di Montalcino, Tuscany

14,5%, Sangiovese

5.500

Casanova di Neri proudly produces the White Label Brunello since 1978. Full body. It is an exciting and extremely multi-layered wine. Exceptionally dense, it exudes a captivating blend of elegance, juxtaposing polished refinement with vibrant character and race.

27. Ornello, Castellare Di Castellina, 1.800 Rocca Di Frasinello, Tuscany

13,5%, Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah 2.800


Early on, Paulo Panerai embraced sustainability, paving the way for the establishment of a nature reserve on the property. Here, the use of herbicides, fertilizers, and chemical pesticides is strictly prohibited. Despite its medium body, the wine unfolds with remarkable fullness and richness, all while preserving the inherent elegance and freshness characteristic of Rocca di Frassinello wines.

28. Da Vero Biologico, IGT Terre Siciliane

14% Nero d'Avola, Organic

The Nero d'Avola grapes are sourced from the picturesque region around Salemi in the Province of Trapani, situated at the north-western tip of Sicily. These vines thrive at an elevation of approximately 250 meters, rooted in a diverse range of soil types that contribute to the wine's unique character. Full body Sicilian organic wine. Fruity and a greedy mouth.



The vineyards of the Primitivo DOC Manduria lie between the towns of Manduria and Avetrana, deep in the Salento territory of Puglia, down in the heel of Italy. The wine spends 12 months in American oak barrels. Full body. Rounded. Ripe and generous with depth of flavour.

NEW ZEALAND

30. Scott Base, Central Otago 13.5%. Pinot Noir

Owned by the pioneering Allan Scott winemaking family from Marlborough, Scott Base vineyards are situated in one of the most beautiful regions of Aotearoa. This Pinot Noir embodies a light body, encapsulating the quintessence of Kiwi craftsmanship. With a palate that dances lightly with fruitiness and a nose that delivers an impactful punch, it captures the essence of New Zealand's distinct winemaking style.

34. Cutio, J. Navascues, Cariñena, Aragón 14.5%, Garnacha, Cariñena, Natural

35. Albahra, Envinate, Almansa, Castilla






